### Fire Captain Candidate Requirements

- Any combination of training, experience and education which demonstrates the ability to perform the duties of the position. Formal or informal education and/or training at a level which ensures the ability to perform mathematical computations and written reports at a level necessary for successful job performance.
- A minimum of five (5) years of full-time experience in the fire service (any rank)
- Possession of a high school diploma, G.E.D. equivalency or a high school proficiency certificate
- Valid California Class C Driver's License with California Firefighter Endorsement and current DL-546 on file
- Current California EMT or Paramedic certification (San Diego County accreditation required upon appointment)
- Current American Heart Association (AHA) Health Care Provider CPR and/or ACLS certification
- California State Board of Fire Services Fire Officer certification (Chief Officer certification highly desirable)
- OES-CSTI (or equivalent) Hazardous Materials First Responder – Operational certification
- OES-CSTI (or equivalent) Hazardous Materials First Responder – Incident Commander certification
- National Wildfire Coordinating Group (NWCG) S-190 Introduction to Fire Behavior
- Successfully pass VCFPD Captain's Test (minimum score: 70% cumulative)
  - Qualification Review (10%)
  - Emergency Incident Simulation (30%)
  - Performance Assessment Exercise (30%)
  - Oral Interview (30%)
