FIRE CAPTAIN POSITION

The Valley Center Fire Protection District is recruiting and testing to establish a list of qualified candidates for the position of Fire Captain.

The Valley Center Fire Protection District is 87.0 Sq. miles with a population of approximately 20,000. The District is a rural suburban area located in North San Diego County California. The District contains heavy wildland urban interface areas with rugged terrain consisting of a main valley floor with hillsides and steep canyons. The fire department responds to 1,400 calls for service a year. The District is governed by a 5 member Board of Directors elected at large from the community.

Currently Fire and Emergency Services are provided by 6 full time Captains, 6 full time Engineers and 24 part-time Firefighters. Paramedic Services are provided through a Public Private Partnership with Mercy Ambulance. Administrative and Prevention Services are provided by a District Administrator, Fire Marshal, Accountant and an Administrative Assistant employed by the District.

The Valley Center Fire Protection District operates from 2 Fire Stations strategically located with two Type 1 Engines, 1 ALS Ambulance, 1 ALS Rescue Squad and 1 Duty Chief.

When employed, the Fire Captain at the direction of the Fire Chief will provide command and control of all risk emergency incidents, provide program and project management, perform life safety inspections, deliver public education, provide instruction and mentorship to Firefighters.

Rate of Pay: \$82,000 to \$88,560 annually, based on experience.

Health Care Stipend: \$4,800 Annually

Holiday Pay: 13 holidays paid at 8 hours

Sick Leave: 48 hours per year

Vacation: 96 hours per year based on length of service with the District

Uniforms: Provided by the District

Deferred Compensation Program: VCFPD 457b program available

Employment Status: Full-time; FLSA non-exempt, 1 year probationary period
