FIRE CAPTAIN POSITION

The Valley Center Fire Protection District is recruiting and testing to establish a list of qualified candidates for the position of Fire Captain.

The Valley Center Fire Protection District is 84.5 Sq. miles with a population of approximately 23,000. The District is a rural suburban area located in North San Diego County California. The District contains heavy wildland urban interface areas with rugged terrain consisting of a main valley floor with hillsides and steep canyons. The fire department responds to 2100 calls for service a year. The District is governed by a 5 member Board of Directors elected at large from the community.

Currently Fire and Emergency Services are provided by six full time Captains, six full time Engineers, Six full-time Firefighter-Paramedics and twenty four part-time Firefighters. Ambulance and additional paramedic services are provided through a public/private partnership with Mercy Ambulance. Administrative and Community Risk Reduction services are provided by a Fire Chief, two Division Chiefs, one Battalion Chief-Fire Marshal, one Administrative Assistant and an Accountant employed by the District.

The Valley Center Fire Protection District operates from 2 Fire Stations strategically located with two Type 1 Engines, 1 ALS Ambulance, 1 ALS Rescue Squad and 1 Duty Chief.

When employed, the Fire Captain at the direction of the Fire Chief will provide command and control of all risk emergency incidents, provide program and project management, perform life safety inspections, deliver public education, provide instruction and mentorship to Firefighters.

Annual Compensation: \$82,000 to \$98,769.95 annually, based on experience (includes salary, holiday pay and other mandated pay in accordance with FLSA)

Sick Leave: 48 hours per year

Vacation: 96 hours per year based on length of service with the District

Uniforms: Provided by the District

Deferred Compensation Program: VCFPD 457b program available

Employment Status: Full-time; FLSA non-exempt, 1 year probationary period
